### Membership Fees

<b>Junior</b> membership fee is	\$70.00.	<i>After 1 January - \$35</i>

- ***Junior** membership is available to those who are 18 years or younger on 1 July 2024.*

### Grading Examination

Grading opportunities are only offered to financial members of the AKR and QKR or to financial members of an International Kendo Federation affiliate that can prove they are eligible to grade.

To be eligible for grading examination, members must meet the requirements as per the Australian Kendo Renmei – [Time in Grade requirements](#).
